Medical documents regarding the patient's state of health and medical history are kept for a period of 100 years, according to the National Archives Law no. 16/1996.

Data recipients

Biofarm will not share/transfer this data to other processors without the consent of the data subject. The data mentioned in the individual reporting sheets will be communicated to the competent authorities, in accordance with the applicable legislative provisions.

Personal data will not be subject to an international data transfer.

Data subjects' rights

You have the right to request from the processors, regarding the personal data relating to the data subject, access to them, their rectification or deletion or restriction of processing or the right to object to processing, as well as the right to data portability.

Additionally, the data subject may exercise, at any time, concerning Biofarm, the right to withdraw its explicit consent.
